Why this book is offered as interactive PDF.

Ebooks are ePub or MOBI files that are specifically built for ereaders. The text in these are reflowable, and redistribute to fill the screen. Readers of these files can adjust font size, typeface, and other viewing options. Just like a web page, ebooks are based on HTML. Ebooks do not have page numbers, so do not reference them in the text. Instead they indicate with references like, "in the next section/chapter/ or at the end of the book." These books cannot be printed by the user. Ebooks are seen as the best file option for something with a great amount of text on an ereader, like a Kindle, a Nook, a Kobo reader, a tablet, an iPod, a phone, etc. Because screens can be small, viewing a PDF requires readers to zoom and navigate to read the content, by manually moving the page from left to right to read it all. However, when viewing enlarged content you will need to scroll across the screen. Also, while PDF file sizes are higher, they retain the quality of higher resolution files, offer interactively, sound files and video. Both formats are constantly under development. The ability to print from a PDF file can be enabled. This PDF file is print enabled which means a printed copy can be made from the PDF file.



WAVE - light - sound - is a series of volumes that present the photographs taken by Lloyd Godman of musicians, and gigs. The title plays on waves in both sound and light. The publications not only present his photographs from the late 1970 period and then the Womad experiences, but the transition from film to digital photography. Godman became interested in photography at an early age and went on to establish the photograph section at the Dunedin Art School which he was head of for 20 years before moving to Melbourne and teaching photography at RMIT. His approach has always asked questions of the medium.

Rarefaction: is the reduction of an item's density, the opposite of compression. Like compression, which can travel in waves, rarefaction waves also exist in nature as in sound waves. A common rarefaction wave is the area of low relative pressure following a shock wave.

Refraction: This bending of light ray, at the surface of separation of two media is called refraction.

Reflection: 1. Reflection is when light bounces off an object. If the surface is smooth and shiny, like glass, water or polished metal, the light will reflect at the same angle as it hit the surface. 2. Serious thought or consideration - looking back on something like an event

Introduction - Vibrations

Wave - sound light Vol 3 offers more photographs of musicians, taken predominately at Womadelaide 2008 2009 with bonus photographs of an amazing band *Planet in Space*, by Lloyd Godman. Rather than a few photographs of a key performer, there is an extensive, rich suite of photographs on each act that most often also features other members of the various bands. Where possible the names of these often unknown musicians are published to afford a greater context to the images.

Besides the acts and the music, the ebook centres squarely on the high quality photographs. Godman's signature style of extreme close up, tight framing, acute angles and slow shutter speeds, that often result in unpredictable blur, continues to take the audience to places they would never have seen or imagined during the actual live performances. From even a few rows back the details revealed in the photographs are lost, while from the back the musicians appear as distant stars that can only be imagined by the music

The photographs in the book allow the viewer to reflect indefinitely on a moment in time captured by the camera. In an age where video might appear king, the still photographs, allows reflection that a single frame from a moving image can not. The single video frame is quickly shunted off the screen by the thousands of frantic frames lined up behind it.

Crucial to the images is both the music and theatre of a live act. When there is magic in the music and magic in the moment an opportunity opens for the camera capture of a stunning image. The musician has to gift both their music while take risk in their antics for a great image. At this point the photographer need a third intersection, that of light.

It is easy to look critically at some of the images and dismiss them as blurred and out of focus. However in these photographs, the subject appears to vibrate like the waves of sound emanating from the amplifiers. The photographs reference earlier photographers who endeavored to escape the tyranny of sharp photographic predictability.

Although evident from the first examples of photography by Louis Jacques Mandé Daguerre, slow shutter speeds and blur have often be seen as affects to avoid in traditional photography. Daguerre's daguerreotype image of Paris' busy Boulevard du Temple street in 1838 is a clear demonstration that a long exposure time erased most of the activity of people on the street. But for one person getting their shoes shined at bottom left of the image human trace is washed away by time.

Slow shutter speeds were a central aspect of the nineteenth century portraits by the British photographer Julia Margaret Cameron. In her lifetime, she was criticized for her unconventional techniques, but also celebrated for the beauty of her compositions and her conviction that photography was an art form. In the summer of 1865, Cameron began using a larger camera, which held a 15 x 12 inch glass negative. She used her new camera to begin a series of large-scale, close-up portraits, which she saw as a rejection of conventional photography in favour of a less precise but more emotionally compelling genera of portraiture.

One of Cameron's earliest celebrity portraits of Alfred, Lord Tennyson, Poet Laureate and one of the most famous writers in England at the time, relies on an accident in the exposure. A close friend of Cameron and neighbour on the Isle of Wight, Tennyson moved slightly during the exposure, resulting in a doubling of the face that gives the portrait a sense of vitality and humanity.

Marcel Duchamp's, brilliant 1912 painting, nude Descending a Staircase, No. 2 (French: Nu descendant un escalier n° 2) had roots in the revelations of time lapse photography and the sequences of Eadweard Muybridge. The work is now regarded as a Modernist classic and has become one of the most famous of its time. However, before its first presentation at the 1912 Salon des Indépendants in Paris it was rejected by the Cubists as being too Futurist.

Acclaimed artist and fashion photographer Richard Avedon, used slow shutter speeds, blur and selective focus to great affect. In his moving paintings, Francis Bacon understood and exploited the sense of time, movement, focus and blur.

These strange other realities offer a duplicity of mystery and truth that a longer shutter speed reveals but can be a void in a sharp stock standard photograph.

As Godman is the first to admit, not all the photographs in the ebook succeed, but juxtaposed along side other photographs as a suite of images that offer reference to a past time and an event ,where musicians preformed and the sounds have long since become silent, the pieces of a puzzle begin to link and create a larger picture that offers a lasting visual memory for those who were there.

For those who did not witness the performances, the images offer the only tangible evidence and can be enjoyed simply as photographs.










































Clube do Balanco

Mamadou invited his cousin Toumani to play with him, and as they had not played together for 7 years this was a very special performance.




























































Planet in Space

St Andrews Pub 2008

A Planet in Space formed in North East Melbourne 2007, and the fourpiece quickly became one of the most intriguing acts on the Australian live scene. At the beginning of 2009, the group thrust its unmistakable music to the world with a debut E.P., As the Pieces Come Together. The talented band cleverly blended roots, rock, reggae, folk, soul, drum-andbass, hip-hop, punk, dub, metal and improvisation – often within the one composition. The group itself was further enriched by a series of potent contrasts arising from the remarkable diversity of the four musicians.
