

#### Why this book is offered as interactive PDF.

Ebooks are ePub or MOBI files that are specifically built for ereaders. The text in these are reflowable, and redistribute to fill the screen. Readers of these files can adjust font size, typeface, and other viewing options. Just like a web page, ebooks are based on HTML. Ebooks do not have page numbers, so do not reference them in the text. Instead they indicate with references like, "in the next section/chapter/ or at the end of the book." These books cannot be printed by the user. Ebooks are seen as the best file option for something with a great amount of text on an ereader, like a Kindle, a Nook, a Kobo reader, a tablet, an iPod, a phone, etc. Because screens can be small, viewing a PDF requires readers to zoom and navigate to read the content, by manually moving the page from left to right to read it all. An ebook, with its reflowable text, provides a much better reading experience. Most major ebook retailers do not allow you to upload a PDF.

A PDF is not a true ebook. Yes, they are electronic, and so are often thought of as an electronic "book," but they are designed to display a hard print-type document that has a fixed layout. So, PDFs will retain the page design and look the same no matter what device you view them on, from a tiny phone to a tablet or computer screen, where as an ebook will scramble the design. For this reason PDFs are excellent where a precise graphic design is required that incorporates complex graphics, images and text. However, when viewing enlarged content you will need to scroll across the screen. Also, while PDF file sizes are higher, they retain the quality of higher resolution files, offer interactively, sound files and video. Both formats are constantly under development. The ability to print from a PDF file can be enabled. This PDF file is print enabled which means a printed copy can be made from the PDF file.





WAVE - light - sound - is a series of volumes that present the photographs taken by Lloyd Godman of musicians, and gigs. The title plays on waves in both sound and light. The publications not only present his photographs from the late 1970 period and then the Womad experiences, but the transition from film to digital photography. Godman became interested in photography at an early age and went on to establish the photograph section at the Dunedin Art School which he was head of for 20 years before moving to Melbourne and teaching photography at RMIT. His approach has always asked questions of the medium.

Rarefaction: is the reduction of an item's density, the opposite of compression. Like compression, which can travel in waves, rarefaction waves also exist in nature as in sound waves. A common rarefaction wave is the area of low relative pressure following a shock wave.

Refraction: This bending of light ray, at the surface of separation of two media is called refraction.

Reflection: 1. Reflection is when light bounces off an object. If the surface is smooth and shiny, like glass, water or polished metal, the light will reflect at the same angle as it hit the surface.

# Introduction - Gifts

While WAVE sound | Volume 8 - is a continuation of publications that presents the photographs I have taken of musicians at WOMAD and other venues that I have taken, it is also part of a larger digital project that documents and presents other art projects. Combined over 30 projects are documented with 6,000 pages.

In any performance a gift is offered. The audience tunes in to the sounds, the visuals and in one way or another accepts the gift, then responds with their own gift, engagement and applause. A charge is built between the two, where an exchange of energy takes place. During the performance of Toumani & Sidiki Diabate the energy builds like a form of meditation, while Oumou Sangare and her musicians and dancers offer a frenzy of energy that builds to a crescendo.

Video records sound and visuals in a predetermined time reference, where frame after frame disappear from the screen replaced by the next in an organized sequence in fractions of a second - the way music flows within a time scape. However in the continuous flow details are lost, obscured in the complexity of image overload.

By contrast, a single photograph offers the opportunity to take in details, interactions within a frozen moment of time.

As a photographer, photographing musicians, I am always looking for visual exchanges of elements within the camera frame. Not always seeing the exact composition, but anticipating the potentials and applying a critical eye in editing. But like the sounds, one can only respond to the visual gifts offered. Stunning theatrical performances from acts like Che Sudaka, La Mambanegra and Lamine Sonko & the African Intelligence are gifts. While there are the stock standard photographs that one might expect, every so often something intriguing emerges in the detail, as in this photograph of Che Sudaka. The performer, jumps the stage leans forward into the audience. His left arm appears to visually merge with the hand of the man in the audience which sets up a peculiar backwards facing thumb. An echo of this the raised thumb is mirrored by the singer in blue framed by the legs of the performer.

Perhaps these might seem like small and eccentric details, but they offer a gift to the viewer of depth within the single frame that certainly escapes attention in a video. Often it is these small details embedded in the frame that I am searching for. The strange juxtaposition of elements within the camera frame.

Take the time to look at these photographs closely and details emerge that open new ways of seeing a performance that has now past.











































## Che Sudaka WOMADELAIDE 2015

Pigments: The finest Epson pigments are used for all prints

Size: The image is printed on A2 paper (420 x 594 mm 16.5 x 23.4 in) with a suitable paper boarder to allow for framing

Framing: While framing for wall mounting can be arranged it is easier to transport the print unframed and offer instructions on framing at your locality

Cost: The prints are offered at \$390 Au per print unframed plus postage and handling




